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Statement for Publication

Points of Exceptional Quality or Innovation

- The induction process for the interim Centre Manager at Conlan is commended.
- There is a staff / student ratio of 1 to 15 and additionally a member of the Conlan Chester school staff accompanies group leaders on each and every excursion so that suitable ratios are always maintained even in the event of an emergency.
- All adults in homestay accommodation are DBS-checked and this continues to be recognised as very good practice

Outcome of Inspection
