## Statement for Publication

Since the last inspection in October 2018, Swindon School of English has made considerable progress in addressing areas for improvement identified by the inspectors. The school benefits from a small staff team who have worked co-operatively together over a number of years. The atmosphere in the school is welcoming and friendly and good rapport between staff and students is evident and confirmed by interviews. Programmes which suit the needs of students who are temporarily or permanently resident in the locality are offered. These programmes also provide opportunities for study to refugees, often free of charge if funding cannot be found.

Swindon School of English does not accept junior students; this avoids the necessity for a range of welfare measures. As juniors were only enrolled on rare occasions this is a cost effective measure. The school has the advantage of being one of only two language schools in the Swindon area and provides a good service to its students.

It has a dedicated team and has clearly demonstrated the drive to raise standards to achieve accreditation.
